St. John's Parish Directory is at the fingertips of all our members, whether they choose the online version or the printed one, or both! As the new year begins, it's time to ensure your information is current.

"One of the main reasons we launched our electronic directory last year was for the ease of keeping it current from day to day and year to year. With very little effort from each of our members, we can always have the latest information ready to use to stay connected as a parish family." said Fr. Tom Fanning.

Each January and July, the church office will remind you to check your family's listing to be sure it's accurate and submit any changes that are needed. You can change your family photo, too, if you like, or add one if you've not done that. Don't forget, you don't have to wait for our reminders as you can submit changes any day of the year.

Simply open your church directory phone app or log in on the web version, click on "Families" and review your family's information. If no changes are needed, no further action is required.

If you do have something that needs to be updated, select "Menu." Next, select "Edit My Family." There, you can make any necessary changes or additions to:


- Names of all family members

Please click on the "Groups" button, check to see if your name should be added or removed from any group and email the office if it does.
