I hope all of you are doing well as we begin the new church year.

Advent, the name which is derived from the Latin word for "coming," is a time of preparation and expectations for the coming celebration of our Lord's nativity, and for the final coming of Christ in power and glory. Thus, this Church season, we anticipate the celebration of the birth of the Christ Child. This past Sunday we celebrated the 1st Sunday of Advent, with a special service performed by our choir in conjunction with our youth. The first advent candle was lit and an advent reading was shared. I am happy to say that all Sundays in Advent will have a similar joyful, youth-infused service.

This year, we will have two services on Christmas Eve. Since Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday, the schedule will be somewhat different from years past. The 4th Sunday of Advent service will be held at 10:30 AM and The Nativity of our Lord will be held at 5:30 PM. There will be a children's program during the 5:30 PM service.

for the 2025 Annual Council, please let me know. Optionally, you may send an eMail to the church office to express your interest. The Vestry will vote during the January vestry meeting to elect the 2025 delegates and alternates.

Lastly, we are in the process of hiring an Interim Rector. I, like many of you, am sad that Mother Elizabeth is unable to continue as our Interim. I am, however, happy for her and her new role. This new position has allowed her and her husband to purchase a home in Jackson County. Now that they are Coast residents, we will continue to see her from time to time. And, for now, she is scheduled to serve us on December 24 and 31.

Finally, I believe our Lord has a bigger plan than I can possibly know. If you are like me, you don't care much for change. But, I firmly believe our Lord has a plan for us as we change our Interim Rector Leadership; A new Interim Rector will bring new perspectives and new God-provided guidance. I look forward to seeing where we go from here.

In closing, I look forward to serving God through serving you this Advent, Christmas, and through all Church seasons of 2024.

• IRS rules recognize a contribution on the day of delivery. For contributions to be deductible for 2023, they must meet one of the following criteria:

By Mail: Postmarked on or before December 31, 2023.

By Hand-Delivery: Received in the church office by noon, December 28, 2023. Any gifts dropped off after the office is closed will be treated as 2024 gifts.

• Online Giving: Use our secure online giving option. Please visit www.sjecpm.org and follow the link for Online Giving. Once there, you can choose to make a one-time gift or a recurring gift. Please note that any gifts given via an online payment

service are dated on the actual date your bank transmits or otherwise removes the funds from your account, <u>NOT</u> on the date that you schedule or submit the transaction.

- Tax situations vary. There have been changes in the tax law. We encourage you to consult with your tax or financial advisor regarding any charitable donations or gifts.
